OTHER STAMP TIPS:

- Use the 75 dpi (dots per inch) version on the web; use the 300 dpi for print
- Use the small version ("small" or "PDF/noGW") without the "Greater Washington" text for small spaces, like email signatures.
- High resolution files (.eps) are for high quality/large printing. Only photo programs, such as Adobe Illustrator or other special software will open these files, but you can send them directly to your printer or designer.
- If your professional printer asks, our PMS color is 5425.
